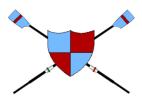

Fee circulated the name of the following new members who have joined provisionally pending Committee approval. The following new members were approved:

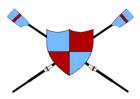

Captain's Report

Rowing Update

After a busy March, April has been a much quieter one from a rowing perspective with Easter in the middle meaning a large number of people were away.

The one race that the club attended was the row the Dart event where, Kirsty, Jane, Alex and Ellie attended along with a Masters crew. The feedback on the event was very positive with Ellie winning her category.

The club has also planned to run Lymington Offshore Regatta in partnership with Lymington Town Sailing Club with a lot of effort put into by Jane and her helpers. There was a great take up and lots of interest generated but regrettably strong winds from the wrong direction meant we had to cancel the event.

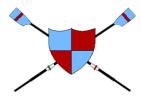
Looking forwards, we are getting ready for the 1st race of the Hants and Dorset season at Milford. Pete and Rebecca have been working hard and it is really encouraging to note we have a big entry (143 crews). Fingers crossed that the weather is decent.

Organisational Challenges

The biggest challenge personally is getting the organisational structure working well and building out the support network. Personally, for the short term need to halve the amount of time I am spending down the club (currently 6 days per week) due to work commitments.

Areas where I believe we need to focus are;

- 1. Ensure that there is an appropriate system to maintain the boats someone is the point person for this. I am very concerned about wear and tear on the equipment.
- 2. Captains need to ensure that they have a clear plan for respective squads and that the crews are supported on the water. Think we have made significant progress on this.
- 3. Identify gaps where we need new people to come into potential roles and introduce over the summer with a view to voting on in October.
- 4. Agree rota for all H&D events for the Captains to attend and tow the boats to H&D events had added this to Google sheet but it has been deleted.
- 5. Develop a training program for people who are new to the club equipment, handling boats etc.
- 6. Introduce a Junior Rec row product to develop basic skills before entering Junior Squa



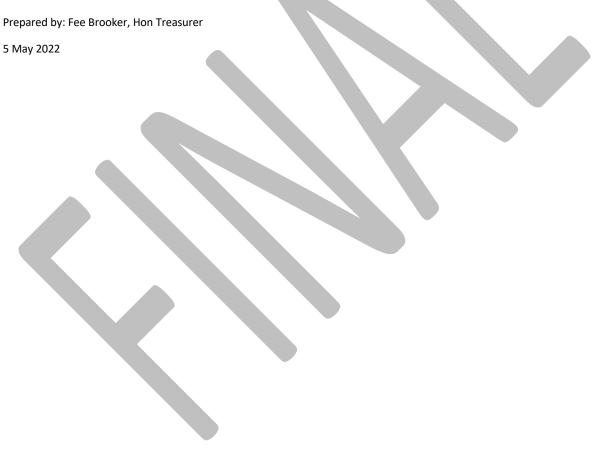
Finance Report – for the month of April 2022

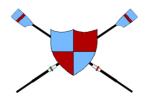
We received £893 of membership income during the month and the other income this month was from entry fees for MoS regatta which have started to come in - £288 so far.

Before cancellation of Lymington Offshore, we had received entry and sponsorship income of £792 and paid event insurance of £242. These amounts will have to be refunded reducing our bank balance by a net £550.

On the expenditure side, the major items were £1,227 paid for the renewal of the pontoon license as well as affiliation fees to H&D of £260. There was no capex this month.

We closed the month with a cash balance of £18.5k (including the £550 above). This is after investments in rowing assets in the 7 months to 30 April 2022 of £16k.
